Between December the 10th and January the 20th, the French environmental enforcement of the Occitanie region and French Guyana led 32 inspections aiming to control trade in caviar from sturgeon species (*Acipenseriformes* spp.).

Inspections focused on the lot identification number, the non-reusable labels affixed to each primary container and the seal of the primary container by those labels. When the non-reusable labels did not seal containers properly, controls looked at whether the caviar was packaged in such a manner as to permit visual evidence of any opening of the container or not.

17 controls detected non-compliance to the caviar labelling provisions. Environmental police have opened **29 enquiries**.

329 primary containers corresponding to 9,750kg of caviar of sturgeon, for a value approximate to 15000€, were seized during this operation.

Caviar seized comes from processing plants in France and China. Depackaging plants are located in France, Germany and Spain.
